







The Brooklyn Baseball Club (the future Brooklyn Dodgers) first played in Washington Park stadium in Gowanus from 1883-1891. They moved to Brownsville briefly, then came back to Gowanus and played at the second Washington Park, until 1913 when they moved to Ebbets Field in Flatbush. The Left Field Wall of the second Washington Park stadium still stands today on 3rd Ave. 1883-1913. The name the Dodgers was derived from the Trolley Dodgers, inspired by the streetcars that operated by the ballpark in Gowanus.

The History of Gowanus

A symbol of Brooklyn's industrial heritage. Founded in 1898, Kentile Floor Company produced vinyl, cork and rubber tiles that contained asbestos. This sign was 8-stories tall and was a landmark of the Gowanus skyline; finally taken down in 2014.




Citizens Works — Gas plants were constructed to convert coal transported down the canal into gas. Much of the leftover coal tar from the factories was dumped directly into the canal.



The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency is overseeing a Superfund


clean-up of the canal.


